Sir,

With reference to your letter No. 8689 dated 24th November 1941, I have the honour to state that the Senbag Islamia Senior Madrasah in the district of Noakhali is hereby granted recognition provisionally for a period of two years with effect from 1st June 1941 with permission to present candidates at the Alim Examination conducted by the Board of Central Madrasah Examinations, Bengal, on the following conditions :-

- 1) That accounts should be opened with the Postal Savings Banks in respect of prize, library and general funds.
- 2) That wall maps of India, Europe, Africa and America should be made available.
- 3) That a V.M. passed Pandit should be appointed at an early date.
- 4) That the library should be enriched with 30 books on the juvenile interest both in Bengali & Urdu and some reference books and a classified catalogue maintained.
- 5) That financial condition should be improved and provident fund started.
